



U Series of Poker (USOP) Player Protection & Liability Policy

1. Purpose

The U Series of Poker ("USOP") is committed to providing a safe and professional tournament environment. This policy sets out the responsibilities, protections, and disclaimers applicable to all participants, spectators, and associated individuals present at USOP venues.

2. Player Acknowledgement

By registering for and/or attending any USOP event, players expressly agree to the terms of this policy, including but not limited to the following:

- USOP is **not responsible** for any personal injury, illness, accident, theft, property loss, or damages that may occur at the venue, including surrounding areas, unless directly caused by proven gross negligence of USOP.
- Players attend and participate in events **at their own risk**.
- Each participant is responsible for their own personal health, safety, and belongings.

3. Emergencies & Force Majeure

- In the event of **medical emergencies, accidents, or unforeseen natural events** (such as fire, earthquake, flood, or other force majeure circumstances), USOP representatives may use the personal information provided during registration to **contact family members, spouses, or designated partners** for notification and assistance purposes.
- USOP reserves the right to suspend, modify, or cancel any event in response to emergencies or government/venue directives, without liability for refunds or damages beyond what is expressly stated in the event's registration terms.

4. Personal Conduct

- Players must follow all venue safety guidelines, tournament rules, and staff instructions.
- Any disorderly, aggressive, or unsafe behavior will result in immediate removal from the venue without refund.

5. Insurance & Personal Responsibility

- USOP strongly recommends that all players obtain appropriate **travel, health, and accident insurance** before attending events.
- Players are solely responsible for covering their own medical costs, transport, or other personal expenses in the event of illness or injury.
